Boating and pedestrian restrictions in place near the Pensacola Bay Bridge

Chipley – Boaters and pedestrians are reminded to exercise additional caution near the Pensacola Bay Bridge construction site, particularly during the July 4 holiday period and the Blue Angels Air Show on July 7 and 8. Boaters should use only the main navigational channel when approaching the bridge and keep a safe distance from the construction barges in the bay.

In addition, the shoreline area, beginning at the wayside park north of the Pensacola Bay Bridge and continuing west along Bayfront Parkway, is closed and will not be available to spectators for the July 4th fireworks show. This area is part of the active construction zone and must be closed in the interest of public safety.
